# DECLARATION

of Kozloduy NPP PLC Managers on its long-term intentions  
for the Company management

**The Aim** of the Kozloduy NPP PLC Management is the safe, effective and environmentally friendly electricity generation with guaranteed quality and reliability in compliance with the national and international requirements and licences issued by the regulatory authorities.

As a **highest priority** the Company Management declares the high level of safety in compliance with the standards applied through continuous enhancement of safety culture.

The Management shall apply an Integrated Management System to achieve the aim as set led by its commitments to:

- ensure nuclear safety and radiation protection;
- protect the environment, public and personnel;
- optimize electricity and thermal power generation;
- sustain high level of maintenance quality and technical support;
- physically protect nuclear facilities, nuclear material and radioactive substances ;
- safe spent nuclear fuel and radioactive waste management;
- continuous development of the quality assurance system;
